


**Figure 15.12. From the workers' party to the party of the highly educated: the Labour vote, 1955-2017**



**Interpretation.** In 1955, the Labour party obtained a score that was 25 points lower among top 10% highest-education voters than among bottom 90% lowest-education voters; in 2017, the score of the Labour party was 13 points higher among top 10% education voters.
