


Figure 15.17. Political conflict & ethnic categories, Britain 1979-2017



Interpretation. In 2017, the labour party obtained 44% of the vote among voters describing themselves as "Whites", 81% among "Africans-Caribbeans", 82% among "Indians-Pakistanis-Bengladeshis" and 69% among "others" (including "Chinese", "Arabs", etc.).
