
Figure S14.19b. The cleavage over inequality in France 2000-2020



**Interpretation.** In 2002, 63% of voters believed that we should reduce the gap between the rich and the poor (vs 37% thinking the opposite); in 2017, this proportion was equal to 52% (vs 48% thinking the opposite).
